



COMMITTEES & COUNCILS

The Ambassador Committee-is comprised of members who are eager to promote the Chamber. This committee is instrumental in implementing and hosting many special events. An Ambassadorship is an opportunity to learn about new businesses and services coming into the Chamber and to network with others to promote their own business. They meet on the first Thursday of each month at 8:00 am.

The Business Development Committee- encourages growth of existing companies through a regular visitation program. Committee members are responsible for informing businesses of services and available assistance, and host an annual dinner honoring the contributions of new and expanded businesses. Meets on the third Tuesday of each month at 8:30 am.

The Education & Business Partnership Committee-includes representatives from the education and business community and is focused on establishing ways to foster positive relationships between our businesses and classrooms. The committee raises funds for the Foundation Teachers Scholarship and assists with the annual Adult Spelling Bee. Meets on the second Monday of each month at noon.

The Fort Pierce Area Council has an elected boards with the chairman of each serving on the Chamber's Board of Directors. This council is responsible to be fully aware of and take actions that support the economic welfare of the Fort Pierce area and its businesses by addressing issues brought to their attention by Chamber members, the Board of Directors and the citizenry. The Leadership St. Lucie Council-oversees the administration of Leadership St. Lucie, and is in charge of seeking additional ways to encourage our members' leadership roles in the community. The council is made up of Leadership St. Lucie Alumni and meets on the first Wednesday of each month at 5:00 pm.
